Instructions for Penile Self Injections-Triple P (Trimix) Solution General Urology Clinic

Home Care

- 1. You are currently using Triple P Solution _____cc. The concentration of each ingredient is: ____ mg/mL of Papaverine, ____ mg/mL of Phentolamine, and ____ ug/mL of PGE1 (prostaglandin).
- 2. You should inject no more than 3 times weekly.
- 3. You MUST wait at least 24 hours between injections.
- 4. The most common side effect of Triple P Solution is mild to moderate pain. You may see a small amount of bleeding at the injection site.
- 5. If you have an erection that lasts longer than four hours, you need to call our clinic immediately or go to Emergency Room.
- 6. If you do not get an erection after injecting the medication, **DO NOT REINJECT**. You must wait 24 hours before trying again.
- 7. Triple P Solution is a 2.5 ml dose vial. Syringes can be used one time only. Dispose the syringes carefully in an appropriate **biohazard** container after use. Do not dispense in regular trash.
- 8. To prevent scar tissue build up, it is best to rotate or alternate the injection site from side to side.
- 9. DO NOT increase the dose of your medication without calling our urology clinic first.

Special Instructions

- 1. Call if you have any questions or concerns regarding treatment.
- 2. If you are on blood thinners, apply pressure for 5 minutes
- 3. Keep medication in refrigerator and in the box in which you received it.
- 4. You will need to call the clinic for refills.

Follow-up Care

We will continue to see you in clinic for follow-up.
