Asexual people (or aces) experience little or no sexual desire or attraction. While most asexual people desire emotionally intimate relationships, they are not drawn to sex as a way to express that intimacy.

Asexuality isn't...	Asexual individuals might...
Abstinence because of a bad relationship	Want friendship, understanding, and empathy
Abstinence because of religious reasons	Fall in love
Celibacy	Experience arousal and orgasm
Sexual repression, aversion, or dysfunction	Masturbate or have sex
Loss of libido due to age or circumstance	Not have sex
Fear of intimacy	Be of any gender, age, or background
Inability to find a partner	Have a spouse and/or children
	Connect with those who have a medical condition that prohibits sexual relationships
