Music Therapy Internship

Wolfson Children's Hospital is committed to providing a quality learning experience to students by offering a 1040-hour internship which provides a clinical experience to develop professional skills in preparation for a career in music therapy. The internship includes clinical experience in the PICU, CVICU, NICU, hematology and oncology, behavioral health, and the acute floors. This internship is designed to facilitate the student's growth as a professional by participating as a member of an interdisciplinary healthcare team. Interns will gain an understanding of the impact of hospitalization on the psychosocial and developmental needs of children by working with patients who are hospitalized for a variety of acute and chronic diagnoses. Interns will have the opportunity to develop skills in assessment, treatment goals, procedural support and teaching, documentation and family support. The intern assumes increasing responsibility for planning and implementing interventions. Interns will be required to complete basic assignments that will be explained in greater detail at the start of the internship.
