

Transportation resources for cancer treatment

Reliable transportation is an important part of staying on track with your treatment. This guide includes options for cancer patients who need help getting to medical appointments.

General transportation – non-medical

Provides free rides to cancer-related medical appointments through volunteer drivers. Rides are pending on driver availability and passengers must be able to get in/out of a car independently. A three-day notice is necessary to request a ride.

Real time updates available for family peace of mind. Also offers meal, grocery and pharmacy delivery as well as home services, i.e., landscaping and handyman work.

County transportation for cancer related appointments

Please contact the Baptist MD Anderson Cancer Center social services department for assistance with the application for any of the counties listed below.

- **Jacksonville Transit Authority (JTA)**

Offers a paratransit program that provides Baptist MD Anderson patients with door-to-door transportation services for their oncology appointments.

- **Connexion**

Provides shared transportation services, small shuttle bus, anywhere within Duval County.

- **Connexion Plus**

Provides private, same-day services anywhere in Duval County.

May be able to provide transportation services for individuals over the age of 70 and with a chronic illness or disability. Is based on volunteer availability for rides.

Will provide out-of-county transportation to Baptist MD Anderson with an application requesting this service. Only travels to Duval County during specific times of the day.

The shuttle comes to Duval County three times a day, Monday – Friday.

Financial Resources for Transportation

Some cancer foundations provide financial assistance or gas cards to defray the cost of travel to cancer related appointments. Please contact the Social Services department if assistance is needed with an application.

Provides gas cards, commercial bus tickets or Amtrak tickets to medical-related treatments. These trips must be more than 50 miles from your home address.
